
We hope you have fun completing these tasks together!

PROJECT 1: Writing

- Write and illustrate a simple story about an animal.
- Write and illustrate a very simple poem about an animal.
- Learn to spell the following high frequency words: I, no, go, to, the, into, you and was.

PROJECT 2: Art and Design

- Make a collage of an animal that lives in the Indian sub-continent. Use as many different materials as you can.
- Research the work of the artists Piet Mondrian and Wassily Kandinsky. What is the link between their artwork? Complete some artwork of your own in their style.

PROJECT 7: Reading

'Drift away with a good book'. Choose a book that you love to read. It could be an information, poetry or story book. Bring the book into school to share with the class and be prepared to discuss what it is you like about your book.

PROJECT 8: Own interest

Tell, show, draw, demonstrate, design or create a project on a topic of your own interest. Be prepared to present your project.

PROJECT 3: Science

- Empty your toy box of play animals and collect your cuddly toys. Sort them into the five classes of animal.
- Choose an animal that lives in the Indian sub-continent. Draw the animal and label the features that enable it to live in that climate.
- Describe the difference between an object and a material. Look at objects around your house and discuss the material that they are made from.

PROJECT 4: History and Geography

- Take a walk around Englefield Village or a village local to you. Look at the buildings in the village and discuss what they are used for.
- On a copy of a World map, mark and try to remember, the continents and oceans.
- What is climate change? How is this affecting the world? List five things that you will commit to do in order to show Love of God's World.

PROJECT 5: French

- Make a box/bag containing at least five animals which you can name in French.

PROJECT 6: R.E

- Find a Bible story you would like us to read and discuss as a class.
- What is the Christian period of Lent? Is there something you can do to help others/the environment during Lent?
