There is the option to complete a project of your child's choice and this can be on any topic.

## Shared Learning Summer 2025-26

### PROJECT 1: Love of Others

- Choose a King or Queen. Find five historical sources e.g. Photos, diary, statues to learn about that monarch. Present your findings in a suitable form.

### PROJECT 2: Love of God's World

- Grow something from seed. From when you plant the seed to when the plant is fully grown, think about the parts of the plant and the function of each part.

### PROJECT 3: Love of Self

- Enjoy visiting a park or place of interest you have not visited before. Write a letter to a friend, telling them why they should/should not visit the place themselves.

### PROJECT 7: Love of Self

Choose a well-known children's author and read three books written by them. Compare and contrast the books. Write your ideas about: the connections between the books, puzzles, likes and dislikes. You could repeat this project for another children's author.

### PROJECT 8: Love of Self

Tell, show, draw, demonstrate, design or create a project on a topic of your own interest. Be prepared to present your project.

### PROJECT 3: Love of Others

- Use your Purple Mash log in (inside your Reading Record front cover) to explore Purple Mash. Remember to save anything you do in your 'My Work' folder, date it and mark on this sheet that it is done. You might like to print your work to add to your Shared Learning book.

### PROJECT 4: Love of God's World

- Take a photograph of at least five 'objects of nature that make you feel grateful for the wonderful world we live in. Present your photos in a creative way.

### PROJECT 5: Love of Others

- Read the book 'How many legs?' by Jim Field. (available on You Tube). Choose a group of your friends/family members and their pets to create your own version.

### PROJECT 6: Love of God

- Research what a parable is. Read a parable in a children's bible. What is the message within the parable and what does this tell us about what God is like?
